Scale scores have the same meaning for all the different forms of the ACT® test, no matter which date a test was taken. Your Composite score and each test score (English, mathematics, reading, science) range from 1 (low) to 36 (high). The Composite score is the average of your four test scores, rounded to the nearest whole number.

Understanding Your Scores - The ACT Test | ACT

The exam consists of three ACT sections: Critical Reading, Math and Writing. The score range for each section is from 200 to 800, so the best ACT score possible is 2400. A student's raw score on the ACT Critical Reading section, and ACT Math section, are converted into two scaled scores (reported on a 200- to 800-point scale).

The ACT exam consists of four parts: English Language, Reading, Mathematics, and Science. Each category receives a score between 1 (lowest) and 36 (highest). Those four scores are then averaged to generate the composite score used by most colleges. ACT's 2019-2020 reporting year covers tests taken between 2017 to 2019.

The ACT is out of 36 points. It consists of four multiple-choice sections—English, Math, Reading, and Science, each scored out of 36 points. The rounded average of these four section scores becomes your composite score. There's also an optional Writing essay test, scored out of 12 points.
